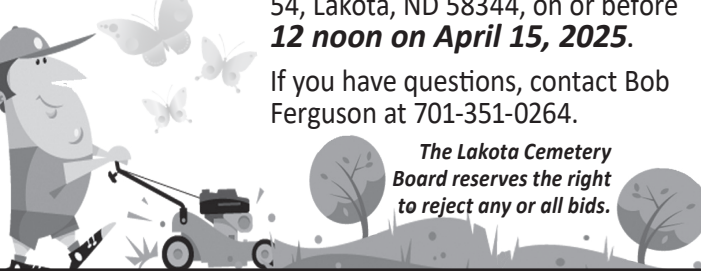

Apply for Melissa Gillett Women's Memorial Scholarship by April 18

The Melissa Gillett Women's Memorial Scholarship seeks to honor Melissa and her legacy by supporting young women who aspire to pursue a post-secondary education. This scholarship will provide support for women enrolled as full-time students in an accredited college, university or technical school program based on merit. To apply for the scholarship, applicants will need to complete an essay which will enable NCHS Foundation to determine their eligibility to receive funds (\$1,000). The funds are provided specifically to help young women who are planning to further their education. One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded per academic year.

Applicants are required to be a graduating female student from Dakota Prairie High School and they must want to pursue a post-secondary education. The scholarship award will be paid upon successful completion of at least 12 semester hours with a 2.0 GPA or higher. The school must send the recipient's grades to Nelson County Health Services Foundation

upon completion.

Applicants should submit a one-page typed essay, 250 words or less, describing why they want to pursue a post-secondary education, their future goals and why they want to receive the Melissa Gillett Women's Memorial Scholarship. Applicants should also provide a current transcript of grades and two letters of recommendation.

Earth Day is now a global event, but its origins are somewhat humble. Prior to the 1960s, awareness of the link between public health and pollution was minimal. However, according to EarthDay.org, the 1962 publication of Silent Spring by American marine biologist, writer and conservationist Rachel Carson was a watershed moment for the environmental movement. The book did much to raise awareness of the effects of pollution on public health. Indeed, the publication of Carson's book proved a pivotal step toward the eventual establishment of Earth Day in 1970, which EarthDay.org characterizes as the dawn of the modern environmental movement.
