NDSU's North Central Research Extension Center in Minot will host a livestock record management program on Tuesday, Jan. 13 from 1 to 3 p.m.

The Ranch Counts and Calculations workshop will provide livestock producers with a hands-on opportunity to learn how to manage and evaluate spreadsheet-based performance records to maximize returns on labor and make confident herd management decisions.

"Management records may be one of the most under-utilized tools in our toolbox," says Lacey Quail, NDSU Extension livestock management specialist. "Calving season is generally a time of year when information gets recorded, but using those records to make informed management decisions is what makes them truly valuable."
