REGULAR MEETING Board of Logan County Commissioners Napoleon, ND July 9, 2025 (unofficial or subject to approval) The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Logan County Com-

missioners was called to order at 1:00pm in the meeting room of the Logan County Courthouse by Chairperson John Wald. Pres-
