Bjerklie discussed the SRSA grant the school was awarded for around \$50,000. The grant could be used to pay title math, counselor schooling, summer library teacher, summer school teachers, and new technology equipment.

be driven to verify mileage. Route 4 needs to be driven to reverify mileage.
