

North Dakota Native Vote Launches Online Candidate Training

North Dakota Native Vote is holding an on-line Candidate Training on October 16 & 17, 2025. The training will consist of two half-day sessions: October 16 from 12pm-4pm, and again on October 17 from 12pm-4pm. The training will explore the foundations of running for local office, how to help other campaigns that you care about, and increase your civic knowledge. Topics will include campaign strategy, public speaking, storytelling, and understanding systems of power. Our goal is to provide a pathway for more people to learn how to run for office, how to take the next steps in the process, and how to support others who are running for office. This training is a step forward in encouraging more Native Americans to run for office and ultimately serve in elected roles in North Dakota and beyond. Native Americans are chronically underrepresented in leadership roles, both in North Dakota and nationwide.

“Our role at North Dakota Native Vote has always been to promote leadership and representation for North Dakota’s Native communities. It has been a goal to create a program that is accessible to all who are interested and are chronically underrepresented” said NDNV executive director, Nicole Donaghy. This event is open to all community members who are interested in running for office or helping with a campaign, and is encouraged for anyone interested in an Indigenous lens of political systems. Medicare Open Enrollment Scams

October marks the start of Medicare open enrollment, and unfortunately, the peak season for Medicare fraud. From October 15 to December 7, eligible beneficiaries can review options and make changes to their Medicare health and Part D prescription drug plans. But not every offer is what it seems. Each year, criminals take advantage of open enrollment

season by posing as insurance providers. They may call, email or show up offering free gifts or limited-time offers, all designed to steal your money, Medicare information, or even your identity. At the same time, advances in modern medical technology create new opportunities for fraud criminals. Medicare beneficiaries should be cautious of devices

advertised as medical monitors or promoted for uses they weren’t designed for. To stay safe, rely only on equipment prescribed by your doctor. To protect yourself from Medicare schemes, avoid sharing personal information with anyone who contacts you unexpectedly about Medicare. Legitimate plans can only reach out if you’ve requested information or already

have an existing relationship with them. Beneficiaries can safely compare legitimate plans and change enrollment by going to medicare.gov or by calling 800-633-4227.
