**City of Carson
February 3, 2025
Regular Meeting Minutes
(Unapproved)**

Present: Mayor Dawn Hanson. Council Members: Tony Zenker, Bailey Stewart, Pete Reis, and Patrick Diehl.

Also present: TJ Osterbauer, Shawn Udell, Trenton Weeks, Shannon Wangsvick, Conner Kelly.

Mayor Dawn Hanson called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm MT. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Bailey Stewart moved to approve the minutes for the January 6, 2025 Regular City Council Meeting. Patrick Diehl seconded – all council members voting “aye” and motion carried.

Tony Zenker moved to pay the following monthly bills as presented and as they are received. Seconded by Patrick Diehl – all council members voting “aye” and motion carried.

City Council reviewed information on DSG water meters. Will be asking them to come in on March 3 to do a demonstration on the water meters, and to answer questions. There will be another meeting with a different company after this one.

TJ has reported six water bills that have been paid in full. Three shut off letters were sent and one we are working on with customer. More discussion on overdue water bills.

Maintenance needed for the Payloader and Blade – Getting an updated quote from RDO Equipment and Bailey checking with Gooseneck.

Park Board - Shannon Wangsvick came to the City Council with a proposal for the Old Grocery Store. They would like to partner with the city to use the building for Office Space and special events. Shannon coming back next month with more information and ideas.

QRU – Requested that Bernae Hertz come and give a report at every City Council Meeting.

Request to give Shawn Udell a raise. Patrick Diehl made a motion to raise Shawn Udell's pay rate. Bailey Stewart seconded, all council members voting “aye” and motion carried.

Yearly reviews to be done for Shawn Udell and Theresa Osterbauer.

Was requested to find out what City of Carson has for Parking Ordinances for winter months. Checking with other cities for what they have.

With no further business, Patrick Diehl made a motion to adjourned and Bailey Stewart seconded all council members voting “aye” and motion carried. Mayor Hanson adjourned the meeting at 9:44 pm MT.
