Patrol identifies woman killed in central North Dakota crash

McCLUSKY, N.D. — The North Dakota Highway Patrol has identified the woman killed Tuesday, April 15, in a central North Dakota crash.

Kathleen Cannon, 67, of McClusky, was killed after the 2015 Dodge Ram 1500 she was driving westbound on North Dakota Highway 200 east of McClusky crossed into the opposite lane

and struck a tractor.

Cole Felchle, 22, of Denhoff, N.D., was driving the tractor. He was not injured. He does not face charges in the crash, the Highway Patrol said.

The road was closed for roughly four hours after the crash. The patrol is continuing to investigate the crash.

McClusky is located in Sheridan County, roughly 65 miles northeast of Bismarck.
