## Bill to update public notice requirements sent to ND governor

BISMARCK — A bill to update how state agencies and political subdivisions notify the public of their activities, and who is in charge of publishing the notices, has been approved by the North Dakota Legislature. Under Senate Bill 2069,

a notice published either on the North Dakota Newspaper Association's website or the "proper" governmental website satisfies the legal requirement if a newspaper fails to publish a notice. A posting is still required to print in the relevant newspaper.

Some entities are legally required to post notices of their meetings in the newspaper. Under North Dakota Century Code, if they neglect to do so or the newspaper fails to publish the notice, the meeting has to be rescheduled.

"We are not removing any requirements for notification posting, said Sen. Kristin Roers, R-Fargo. "What it does is
