French Open to pay tribute to Rafael Nadal

The French Open will honor 14-time champion Rafael Nadal in a ceremony next month on the opening day of play at Roland Garros in Paris.

Nadal, coming off of injuries, lost in the first round to Alexander Zverev at the French Open last summer in his final tournament appearance. The Spaniard retired last fall after Davis Cup play. Nadal, 38, had not

announced his retirement at the time of his most recent French Open, which already has erected a statue of him at Roland Garros, so such a ceremony was viewed as premature, Mauresmo said.

Nadal won 22 Grand Slam singles titles. His record at Roland Garros was 112-4.

Jets sign Neal Pionk to six-vear extension

The Winnipeg Jets signed defenseman Neal Pionk to a six-year, \$42 million contract extension on Thursday.

Pionk, 29, tallied 39 points (10 goals, 29 assists) in 69 games this season for the Presidents' Trophy winners. The Omaha, Neb., native was second on the Jets in ice time (22:04) and tied for third in plus/ minus (plus-21).

The extension will begin with the 2025-26 season for Pionk, who earned a \$6 million base salary this season.

Pionk has recorded 256 points (44 goals, 212 assists) in 536 games with the New York Rangers (2017-19) and
