StormTRACKER Forecast


Highs reach around 90° today. Winds are out of the SE 15-25 mph. Partly cloudy, with a chance for a stray shower.



Spirit Lake Nation extends water consumption ban

Tribe has been without drinkable tap water since **May 27**

FORT TOTTEN, N.D. The Spirit Lake Nation will now be without drinkable tap water until Aug. 22, tribal officials announced Tuesday, July

Residents on the reservation have been without drinking water since May 27, after testing at the tribe's water treatment plant on May 13 and 20

detected increased levels of manganese. Officials had hoped to have drinkable tap water by June 11, but that was postponed to June 25.

According to a post on the tribe's Facebook page on Tuesday, the water consumption advisory has now been extended "through the week of August 18-22, aligning with the expected implementation of a permanent treatment solution."

Officials had hoped to flush at least 4 million gallons of water through the system, but that has been delayed, Tuesday's post said. A temporary

filtration system is in place, but is running at limited capacity. Residents can use tap water for bathing, washing clothes, cleaning fruit and vegetables, and preparing food such as pasta, but water must be discarded before consumption, officials had said earlier.

Daily bottled water distribution will continue at the four District Wellness Centers from noon to 6 p.m. However, the centers will be closed Thursday and Friday, July 3-4, for the holiday. The centers will reopen on Saturday, July 5, the post said.
