#### Woman injured in 4 Bears casino parking lot crash identified

NEW TOWN, N.D. — The North Dakota Highway Patrol has identified the woman seriously injured Saturday, June 28, in a crash in the parking lot of a western North Dakota casino.

According to a release, June Lizotte, 84, of New Town, was injured when a 2006 Ford Five Hundred was backing up in the parking lot of the 4 Bears Casino and Lodge and struck her.

Darrell Osborne, 60, of New Town, was driving the Ford at the time and is facing charges of criminal vehicular injury, a class C felony, according to the Highway Patrol.

A bond hearing for Osborne took place Monday, June 30, in McKenzie County district court, according to court records. His next hearing in the case is scheduled for 1 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 11.

Osborne was

previously charged with driving-related offenses, including driving under the influence and speeding, records show.

The New Town Ambulance took Lizotte to Trinity Hospital in Minot. Neither Osborne nor his passenger, Janice Davis, 62, of New Town, were injured.

The North Dakota Highway Patrol is continuing to investigate the crash, the release said.
