Ashley (Dyste) Bosh, Forman native, publishes debut novel ‘Fragments of Us’

A book signing was held on August 21, 2025 at Forman Drug. Ashley (Dyste) Bosh was welcomed back to the community as a self-published author of her first book "Fragments of Us". About 25 people asked questions, had their books signed and visited with Ashley.

“It’s been such a surreal experience to see a lifelong dream finally come to life in print,” said Bosh about her debut novel. “Fragments of Us,” is a heart-wrenching, soul-soothing story about Emery Blake who is a single mom, abandoned during pregnancy, and Julian Ward, a successful CEO frozen in grief after losing his wife to cancer.

When Emery lands a desperate job in Julian’s company, their lives begin to intertwine.

What begins as irritation slowly becomes fascination, then an emotionally raw and deeply vulnerable connection.

Through quiet hallway glances, fierce arguments, and shared grief, they each begin to rediscover what it means to feel again.

“The story came from a mix of real emotions and ‘what if’ scenarios that kept tugging at me,” explained Bosh. “Because, honestly—I’ve lived that life.

“I’ve rebuilt after being broken. I wanted to show that even in the messiest moments, love and healing can still surprise you.”

The story explores how brokenness doesn’t make you unlovable-it makes you human. And sometimes, healing doesn’t come in grand gestures, but in the quiet moments where someone finally sees you.

Bosh was born and raised in Forman and graduated from Sargent Central in 2004. She currently lives in Oxbow with her husband Zach and three kids: Ella (12), Will (7) and Charleigh (6).

“Most days you’ll find me running kids to different activities, being active in our church, volunteering at their school, or involved in community events,” Bosh said.

“When I’m not writing, I enjoy spending time with family and friends, attending and coaching my kids’ activities, reading, golfing, and traveling.

“Honestly, with three kids in multiple activities, being a personal taxi is where most of my time is spent.”

Professionally she’s spent time working in SaaS (Software as a Service) and IT sales, but lately she has focused in on writing and building a creative business around books and social media.

According to Bosh, she’s always enjoyed writing and speaking.

“Before this book, I was actually a blogger for the Fargo Moms’ platform. Writing has always been my outlet.

“I don’t have a professional background in it, since I actually spent most of my career in sales, but I’ve always had a love for telling stories and connecting with people through words.

As far as her writing process goes?

“Let’s just say my process was a little secretive at first—even my husband didn’t know I was doing it right away,” Bosh said.

“In January, the company I worked for was acquired, and I suddenly had time to finally tackle a bucket list item.

“Being able to check ‘write a book’ off before 40 feels really
