
## Property Owners

The Board recessed at 11:59 a.m. The Board reconvened at 1:00 p.m. for the hearing on the county budget. There being no one present for public input, the Board recessed at 1:14 p.m. until September 23, 2025, at 4 p.m. for budget work.

The Board reconvened on September 23, 2025, at 4 p.m. with Commissioners Jerry Waswick, Scott Johnson, Lyle Bopp, Jason Arth and Chairman Wade Anderson present. Also present were Tim Faber, Road Supervisor; Travis Paeper, Sheriff; and Tia Bopp, Auditor.

Faber was present to share the test results from the gravel that was put up in the Dustin Mund gravel pit. Another gravel contractor has contacted both Faber and Arth and wants to have access to the pit to take samples of the gravel and have his own testing done. Arth will notify the contractor that he cannot go into someone else's pit and take gravel for testing.

Faber also presented two bids for cleaning out the dirt in the ditch on County Road 10 south of Rutland and move that dirt to County Road 12 where dirt is needing to be replaced. Motion to hire Jay Enderson to clean the County Road 10 ditch south of Rutland and haul that dirt to Harvey Bergstrom's on County Road 12. This project will be paid for from the Federal Aid Road fund. (Arth/Johnson) Upon roll call vote, motion carried.

Motion to apply rubberized crack seal on County Road 10 between Highways 11 and 13 for a stretch of six miles. The project is not to exceed \$13,500 with the work being done by Lotpro. This project will be paid out of the Federal Aid Road fund. (Waswick/Arth) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Budget figures and were gone through and adjustments made where necessary. There being no further business the meeting adjourned September 23, 2025, at 5:49 p.m.
