Members were also able to get their hands dirty by making their own flat bread, using a sheeter, and baking in the large oven.

By the end of the day, FBLA members left having contributed meaningfully to their community while exploring entrepreneurship in a hands-on setting. The event served as a reminder that leadership is not just about titles, it's about action, learning, and making a difference.
