Mike moved to approve Ordinance 90 per-taining to Fences, Streets and Alleys. Dale moved to approve Ordinance 91 pertaining to the House Moving Licens-ing and Permits. It will be printed in the Steele Ozone that the first reading was held September 8, 2025. The second reading will be held October 6, 2025 at the city hall at 8:00 PM.

Tree grant update – We are waiting on an estimate for trees from Cashman Nursery. We need to replace a tree for every tree that is cut down.

The bills were reviewed. Doug moved to approve. There is a question on the bills received for cement work by the ball house. These will be clarified before these bills are paid. Pete second-ed. All in favor. MC

An estimate was received from Klim Plumbing to reroute some water lines. This would be done so lines are not running through parts of the school that are not heated.

The County is having a meeting Fri-day, September 19, at 1:00 concerning plans to provide tornado shelters to cit-ies in Kidder County. They would like 2 representatives from the city to attend.

Garbage and sewer bills over \$100 not paid by September 30, 2025 will be added to the tax roll.
