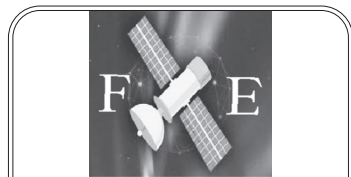

How to budget for a road trip vacation

Food costs
The financial professionals at Chime report that the average traveler spends about \$60 per day on food. Multiply that by the number of travelers, and it's easy to see how quickly food costs can add up. Road trippers can pack a cooler with some grab-and-go options for breakfast and lunch to save a little money.

Additional costs
Driving vacations may come with some other costs, too. Tolls, parking, vehicle maintenance before the trip starts, entry fees to attractions, souvenirs, and more are variables that merit consideration when building a budget. It's also a good idea to have an emergency fund for a breakdown or a splurge.

The proposed changes are effective June 29, 2026, as interim final rules under North Dakota Century Code § 28-32-03(2)(c) to avoid a delay in implementing an appropriations measure (section 2 of 2025 Senate Bill No. 2305); the rules are required for the Department of Health and Human Services to comply with the opinion and order of the Supreme Court for the State of North Dakota in Ferderer v. Copies of the proposed rules are available for review at human service zone offices and at the state-operated behavioral health clinics. Copies of the proposed rules and the regulatory analysis relating to these rules may be requested by telephoning (701) 328-2311.
