

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
MADDOCK CITY COUNCIL
July 20, 2026**

A special meeting of the Maddock City Council was held July 20, 2026. Council President Brad Hermanson called the special meeting to order at 6 p.m. at city hall. Present for roll call were council members DeeDee Olson, Philip Backstrom and Teresa Dosch. Absent was Mayor Dusty Pierson. Also present was Marvin Dosch.

The purpose of the special meeting was to conduct the required public meeting for the city's USDA Community Facilities Grant application. The meeting provided an opportunity for the public to learn about the proposed projects and offer comments before the city proceeds with the application.

The proposed USDA Community Facilities Grant projects were reviewed, including:

- ADA improvements
- Street sweeper
- Two pickup trucks
- Portable generator
- Utility trailer
- City shop concrete apron

The purpose of these projects is to replace and improve city equipment, improve accessibility and better serve city residents.

President Hermanson opened the public hearing and invited questions or comments regarding the proposed USDA Community Facilities Grant application. No public comments were received. President Hermanson then closed the public hearing.

A motion was made by Dosch, seconded by Olson, to proceed with the USDA Community Facilities Grant projects and application as presented. Roll call vote: Olson--yea; Backstrom--yea; Dosch--yea. The motion carried.
