a three-pointer from the right baseline that was blocked by Schumacher, and Janczewski retrieved the loose ball and was fouled with just :03.5 showing on the clock. Janczewski misfired on both shots, and Witt rebounded for KC, but her long pass toward Zimmerman along the right sideline sailed into the crowd with less than a second left, and LHMB inbounded to secure the victory.

LHMB hit on just seven of 15 free throws in the game, including just two of six in the fourth quarter, but the Lady Lions hit on 18 of 46 (39%) field goals, and held a 31-24 advantage in rebounds, including a 17-7 margin on the offensive glass. KC shot just 30% (6 of 20) from the field and turned the ball over 10 times in the second half, and the Wolves finished 18 of 41 (44%) from the floor, committed 18 turnovers and went to the free throw line just three times the entire game, sinking

all three shots.

Schumacher and Janczewski each scored a dozen points to lead LHMB, with Janczewski recording a double double with a game-high 10 rebounds and two steals, and Schumacher grabbing eight rebounds with three assists and two steals. Hase netted 10 points and a pair of steals, while Vander Vorst tallied nine points, two assists and a game-high four steals, and Ryckman chipped in five points, seven rebounds and two assists for the Lady Lions.

Zimmerman scored a game-high 20 points to go along with eight rebounds, two steals and two assists, and Witt netted 10 points and nine rebounds for KC. Pfaff hit three 3-pointers and finished with nine points, three rebounds and two assists, Schmidt chipped in six points and three steals, and Riley Sayler grabbed four rebounds and dished out two

assists for the Wolves.
