Business Manager's Report
Monthly Financial Report/Bills The monthly financial reports and bills were presented and reviewed by the board. Mrs. Malard went over the budget summary and reviewed some of the bills. She advised the board that we had a couple of buses in Bismarck for repairs and may have a couple more that will need to go up for repairs. Superintendent's Report
District Update Mr. Barry provided his Superintendent's report to the board for them to review. He was honored to share that HMB has been recognized as one of the top 10% of all North Dakota Public Schools based on statewide accountability metrics under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), as reported by the ND Department of Public Instruction. We are incredibly proud of this accomplishment. Some of the other things Mr. Barry talked about included Student Learning and Assessments, Teachers Evaluations and Contracts and the Mid-Winter Conference he attended.
