Buckley moved and Morrell seconded to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

Tokach moved and Morrell seconded to approve the minutes of the November 25, 2025 regular meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

Zachmeier moved and Boehm seconded to approve bills and payroll. On a roll call vote, all voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Tokach seconded to approve abatement #7166. All voting aye, motion carried.

election precincts as presented. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Tokach seconded to approve the Special Assessment District #2589 – Prairie Ridge allocation of costs

for a total of \$231,883.81. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Buckley seconded to approve the Special Assessment District #2588 – Yellow Rose/Howl'n Wolf allocation of costs for a total of \$133,675.83. All voting aye, motion carried.

Morrell moved and Tokach seconded to approve the Special Assessment District #2490 – Mantahni allocation of costs for a total of \$233,239.49. All voting aye, motion carried.

Buckley moved and Morrell seconded to approve the Special Assessment District #2586 – Entzel Acres allocation of costs for a total of \$699,683.24. All voting aye, motion carried.

Public Comment period as required by NDCC 44-04-20.1 was opened at 6:05PM. There was no public comments and comment period was closed at 6:05PM.

The total of all county funds expended from November 26, 2025 through December 11, 2025 equals \$1,465,287.94.
