Recipe: **Shrimp Tacos**

Ingredients:

- 1 lb. raw shrimp
- 1 garlic clove, pressed or minced
- ½ tsp sea salt
- ¼ tsp black pepper
- ¼ tsp. ground cumin
- ¼ tsp cayenne pepper
- 1 tsp. olive oil
- TOPPINGS:**
- 8 white corn tortillas (6-inch) or hard taco shells
- ½ small head of purple cabbage, about 2 cups shredded
- 1 large avocado, pitted, peeled, diced
- ½ red onion
- 4 oz. Cotija cheese or your can use Feta or Queso Fresco
- 1 lime cut into 6 wedges
- TACO SAUCE:**
- ½ C. sour cream
- ½ C. mayonnaise
- 1 fresh lime, squeezed
- ¾ tsp. garlic powder
- ¾ tsp. Sriracha sauce or to taste

Directions:

Mix taco sauce ingredients together and set aside. Defrost shrimp and pat dry. Put into a bowl, add the seasonings and garlic and toss together. Heat a large non-stick pan over medium high heat and drizzle in 1 tsp. of olive oil. Arrange the shrimp in a single layer. Saute for 2 minutes on each side. Remove and put on a plate. Toast the tortillas over a medium-low flame or griddle, cooking for about 30 seconds each until they have golden brown spots. To build your taco, top with shrimp, toppings and sauce. Serve with the lime wedges on the side.
