


WBI Energy to host open house at PUMC Church in Ellendale

Next Tuesday (February 24) at 5:00 to 7:00 PM, area residents can visit the Presbyterian United Methodist Church in Ellendale to learn details about the planned Bakken East Pipeline project. This line is intended to bring natural gas from western to eastern North Dakota, with a leg stretching through Barnes, LaMoure and Dickey Counties to Ellendale.

As discussed previously in the Leader, a similar project was proposed nearly 60 years ago, but never came to fruition. Given high demand for gas, and developments in western North Dakota in the past two decades, WBI Energy Transmission, which is connected to MDU Resources Group, is proposing this new project.

A letter from WBI provides some key details about the project: regarding its plan "to build, own, and operate the Bakken East Pipeline Project in North Dakota."

WBI Energy, headquartered in Bismarck, North Dakota, operates approximately 3,800 miles of natural gas transmission pipeline in North Dakota, Montana, South Dakota, Wyoming, and Minnesota. It is planning to expand its current pipeline system to serve new power generation, industrial facilities, and local distribution company demand in central and eastern North

Dakota. WBI Energy has been operating natural gas facilities in North Dakota for nearly 100 years, serving multiple industries and local distribution companies throughout the state. In 2024, WBI Energy constructed the Wahpeton Expansion Project, installing approximately 60 miles of pipeline from Mapleton to Wahpeton and installing new natural gas delivery stations near Kindred and Wahpeton. Additionally, in 2021, it constructed the North Bakken Expansion Project, installing approximately 62 miles of

pipeline from Tioga to a new interconnect southeast of Watford City. The current design of the Project consists of approximately 350 miles of new mainline pipeline in McKenzie, Dunn, Mercer, Oliver, Burleigh, Kidder, Stutsman, Barnes, and Cass Counties, approximately 9 miles of lateral pipeline in Stutsman County, and approximately 82 miles of lateral pipeline in Barnes, LaMoure, and Dickey Counties. The current design also includes construction of two greenfield compressor stations in Barnes, LaMoure stations, addi-

tional compression at three existing compressor stations, and various measurement and interconnection facilities. The map above provides an overview of the planned pipeline route.

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
