Mayor's Corner

From Lacey Hinkle, Mayor of Cavalier

Greetings!

At our March council meeting, members discussed the condition and potential improvements to the Pines Baseball Field. The council reviewed several estimates for minor upgrades that would help maintain the field and improve usability.

The proposed updates include replacing the backstop fencing, applying agrilime to the infield, and installing a new scoreboard. The total estimated cost for these improvements is roughly \$50,000.

Council members also reviewed what would be required if the field were to undergo a full renovation. A complete update would involve additional fencing, gravel work, upgrading dugouts, and installation of drain tile to improve field drainage and overall durability.

After reviewing the estimates and scope of work, the council determined that the cost of a full renovation or any upgrades should be put on hold for now. Ideally, a new location would be best case scenario for the field. If the city is able to purchase land closer to the school in the future, a field will be one of the first priorities. If the Cavalier school were to have a baseball team in the coming years, the co-op with North Border, and their field in Walhalla would be utilized for that team.

The council has also begun discussing plans to update and improve the alleys located behind Main Street businesses. These alleys play an important role in providing access for deliveries, parking, and utility services. In 2025, the alley behind the Catholic Church was paved. We will look at doing the same thing in the other alleys, provided drainage work is completed as well. The City of Cavalier is also planning to demolish the old light plant building before the end of the year. OM Walton is currently working on quotes for the demolition work. The council will review all quotes at our April meeting.

Residents, please be aware that several local positions will be up for election this year. Community members interested in serving the city are encouraged to consider running for office. Positions that will appear on the ballot include:

- Mayor
- Municipal Judge
- Alderman – Ward 1
- Alderman – Ward 2
- Alderman – Ward 3
- (3) Park Board positions

Serving in local government is an important way to help guide the future of the community. Individuals interested in learning more about filing for a position or the responsibilities of these roles are encouraged to contact City Administrator Blair for additional information. The filing deadline is 4:00 pm on Monday, April 6, 2026.
