Recipe of the Week

- Easy Carrot Cake Loaf

- 1 cup packed light brown sugar
 - 1/2 cup vegetable oil
 - 1/4 cup unsalted butter, melted
 - 1 1/2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
 - 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
 - 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
 - 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
 - 2 large eggs
 - 1 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
 - 2 teaspoons baking powder
 - 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
 - 2 cups grated carrots, about 3 large carrots
 - Optional Cream Cheese Frosting
 - 4 ounces cream cheese, softened
 - 2 tablespoons butter, softened
 - 3/4 cup powdered sugar
 - 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease a 9x5-inch loaf pan and line the bottom and two sides with a piece of parchment paper, leaving a slight overhang.

In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the brown sugar, vegetable oil, melted butter, cinnamon, nutmeg, ginger, and salt. Add the eggs and whisk until fully combined. Switch to a silicone spatula and add the flour, baking powder, and baking soda, gently stirring until the batter is mostly combined. Add the grated carrots and chopped walnuts and stir until distributed through the batter and no dry streaks of flour remain.

Pour the batter into the prepared loaf pan and smooth the top with the spatula. Bake until a toothpick inserted into the center of the loaf comes out clean, 50 to 60 minutes. Let the carrot loaf cool in the pan on a wire rack for 10 minutes. Run a butter knife along the two unlined ends of the cake, then use the parchment overhang like a sling to pull the cake out of the pan. Set the cake on the wire rack to cool completely.
