ATTENTION ALL PROPERTY OWNERS CITY OF MINOT NOTICE TO CUT TALL WEEDS OR GRASS

Property owners in the City of Minot are required to mow weeds or grass, before they exceed 8 inches tall, Under Chapter 22 (Nuisances) of the City of Minot Code of Ordinances.

If the tall weeds or grass on a property is determined to be in excess of 8 inches tall, such weeds or grass must be cut within 48 hours. Additional exemptions are outlined in City Ordinance section 22-9. Otherwise, the City of Minot will arrange for cutting; and the cost of such work will be assessed against the property. No further notice to individual property owners is required under Chapter 22. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Minot Park District is requesting Bids for the construction of PAVING IMPROVEMENTS - CORBETT FIELD PARKING LOT. Bids will be received and accepted via electronic bid (vbld) through QuestCDN or in sealed envelopes at the office of Ackerman-Estvold, 1907 17th Street SE, Minot, North Dakota, until 1:30 PM Tuesday, June 9, 2026, at which time all Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud via video conference. All Bids must be submitted, and all work shall be done, in full and strict compliance with:

1. The Plans & Contract Documents for this project;
2. Any Special Conditions for this project;
3. The 2026 City of Minot Standard Specifications and Details.

Generally, the Work covered by the Plans and Specifications for Paving Improvements - Corbett Field Parking Lot consists of the materials, labor, tools, and equipment required for the rehabilitation of the paved parking lot at Corbett Field. The Work shall include the milling of 1400 SY of asphalt pavement, 1060 Ton of asphalt pavement, 3900 SY of cement stabilized base, concrete valley gutter, pavement striping, and other incidentals as necessary to complete the project. Details of the construction are included in the Drawings, Project Manual, and the 2026 City of Minot Standard Specifications and Details.

All Bids are to be submitted on the basis of cash payment for the Work and Materials necessary to complete the project. Each bid must be accompanied by a separate envelope containing the contractor's license and bid security. The bid security must be in a sum equal to five percent of the full amount of the bid and must be in the form of a bidder's bond. A bidder's bond must be executed by the bidder as principal and by a surety, conditioned that if the principal's bid is accepted and the contract awarded to the principal, the principal, within ten days after notice of the award, shall execute a contract in accordance with the terms of the bid and the bid bond and any condition of the governing body. A countersignature of a bid bond is not required under this section. If a successful bidder does not execute a contract within the ten days allowed, the bidder's bond must be forfeited to the Owner and the project awarded to the next lowest responsible bidder. Bidders must be licensed for the full amount of the bid as required by section 43-07-12 of the North Dakota Century Code.

No Bid may be read or considered if it does not fully comply with the requirements of Section 48-01-2.05 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The Owner reserves the right to hold all Bids for 30 days, to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informality or irregularity in any Bid, to accept the

Bid deemed in the best interest of the Owner, and to rebid the project until a satisfactory bid is received.

There shall be endorsed upon the outside of the envelope containing the Bid, the following:

Work may begin on August 17, 2026. All work shall be substantially complete by October 30, 2026. All work shall be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with the General Conditions by November 13, 2026.

Should the Contractor fail to complete its obligations under the Contract within the time required herein or within such extra time as may have been granted by formal extensions of time approved by the Owner, there will be deducted from any amount due to the Contractor the sum of \$500 per day for each and every calendar day that the completion of the Work is delayed. The Contractor and his Surety will be liable for any excess. Such payment will be as and for liquidated damages and not as a penalty.

ANALYSIS OF THE STATEWIDE MEASURES APPEARING ON THE ELECTION BALLOT JUNE 9, 2026

The following analysis is for the measure appearing on the statewide Primary Election ballot on June 9, 2026. This publication is required by section 16.1-01-07 of the North Dakota Century Code to enable voters to become familiar with the effect of proposed measures. The full text of each measure is available on the Office of the Secretary of State's website at vote.nd.gov or by requesting a copy from the Elections Division at 701-328-4146, or from the office of any County Auditor.

In addition, as required by section 16.1-01-17 of the North Dakota Century Code, a copy of the Legislative Council's report on the estimated fiscal impact of initiated Measures No. 1 is available on the Office of the Secretary of State's website at vote.nd.gov, by phone at 701-328-4146, by email at sosselect@nd.gov, or by letter to Secretary of State, 600 E Boulevard Avenue Dept 108, Bismarck ND 58505-0500.

Analysis of Initiated Constitutional Measure No. 1 (Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 4007, 2025 Session Laws, Ch. 615)

Initiated Constitutional Measure No. 1 was placed on the ballot by action of the 2025 North Dakota Legislative Assembly with passage of Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 4007 (2025 Session Laws, Chapter 610). If approved, this constitutional measure would amend and reenact section 9 of article III and section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota, relating to requiring each resolution adopted by the legislative assembly proposing a constitutional amendment and each initiative petition and measure proposing a constitutional amendment be comprised of a single subject. The proposed amendment would require constitutional amendments to be limited to one subject. The Secretary of State shall not approve an initiative petition for circulation if the Secretary determines that the proposed amendment comprises more than one subject. Additionally, the legislative assembly is required to limit proposed amendments to the constitution to one subject.

The estimated fiscal impact of this measure is none.
