CITY OF CASSELTON ORDINANCE NO. 351 NOTICE OF ORDINANCE ADOPTION

The City Council of the City of Casselton, Cass County, North Dakota, has passed and adopted Ordinance No. 351, a Compression Release Brake Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 235, prohibiting the use of compression release brakes within the City of Casselton.

PENALTIES: Any person who engages in the prohibited conduct set forth in Section (1) is guilty of a noncriminal traffic violation punishable by a fine of not more than \$50. Each time a person engages in the prohibited conduct shall be considered a separate offense.
