

**Newburg City Council Minutes  
April 7, 2026 6:00pm  
Newburg Community Center**

Mayor Scott Hunskor called the meeting to order with Dave Heintzleman, Dave Tonneson, Evette Bierman, Jerad Kersten and Emily Hadden present.

The minutes from the March 2, 2026 meeting were read. Dave Tonneson made a motion to accept the minutes, second by Dave Heintzleman, motion carried.

Newburg City Apartment Unit #1 was discussed. Dave Tonneson made a motion to convert apartment #1 back to a regular apartment rather than an Airbnb, second by Jerad Kersten, motion carried.
