

NOTICE OF FAA APPROVAL FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT CONCERNING IMPROVEMENTS AT PARSHALL - HANKINS AIRPORT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has announced an approved Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for an Environmental Assessment analyzing proposed improvements at the Parshall - Hankins Airport, Parshall, North Dakota. The FONSI indicates the project is consistent with existing environmental policies and objectives as set forth in the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and will not significantly affect the quality of the human environment. The Environmental Assessment documents the economic, social, and environmental effects associated with the Airport's intent to lengthen the southeastern end of Runway 12/30 by 492 feet, and implementing GPS Approach/Departure procedures for both runway ends. The intent of the proposed action is to bring the Airport into compliance with FAA Design Group A/B-II small design standards.

The FONSI is attached to the April 2026 Environmental Assessment. In accordance with current FAA guidance, copies of the FONSI and Environmental Assessment will be available through May 29, 2026 (30 days) at the following locations during regular business hours:

Press Freedom On Trial: BEK TV Releases Injustice

A major freedom of the press battle is unfolding in North Dakota, and BEK TV is taking viewers inside the story. The network has launched a powerful new investigative special report series, InJustice, now available to watch at no charge on the BEK TV+ app and over-the-air on BEK TV across North Dakota. This urgent series exposes a real-time legal fight that could reshape journalism in America.

BEK TV has been subpoenaed by a North Dakota prosecutor, demanding the news network's protected internal newsgathering materials, including raw un-aired footage, reporter notes, text messages, and private communications with the victim, Jenni Babcock. These materials are tied to the network's coverage of the Daniel Breijo murder case, Breijo being the defendant. BEK is actively fighting this demand before the North Dakota Supreme Court.

BEK's legal fight highlights growing concerns that prosecutors may be conducting a "fishing expedition" into protected newsroom materials. North Dakota's long-standing Journalist Shield Law is being ignored, confidential sources and whistleblowers could be exposed, and a precedent-setting ruling could weaken press protections across the country.

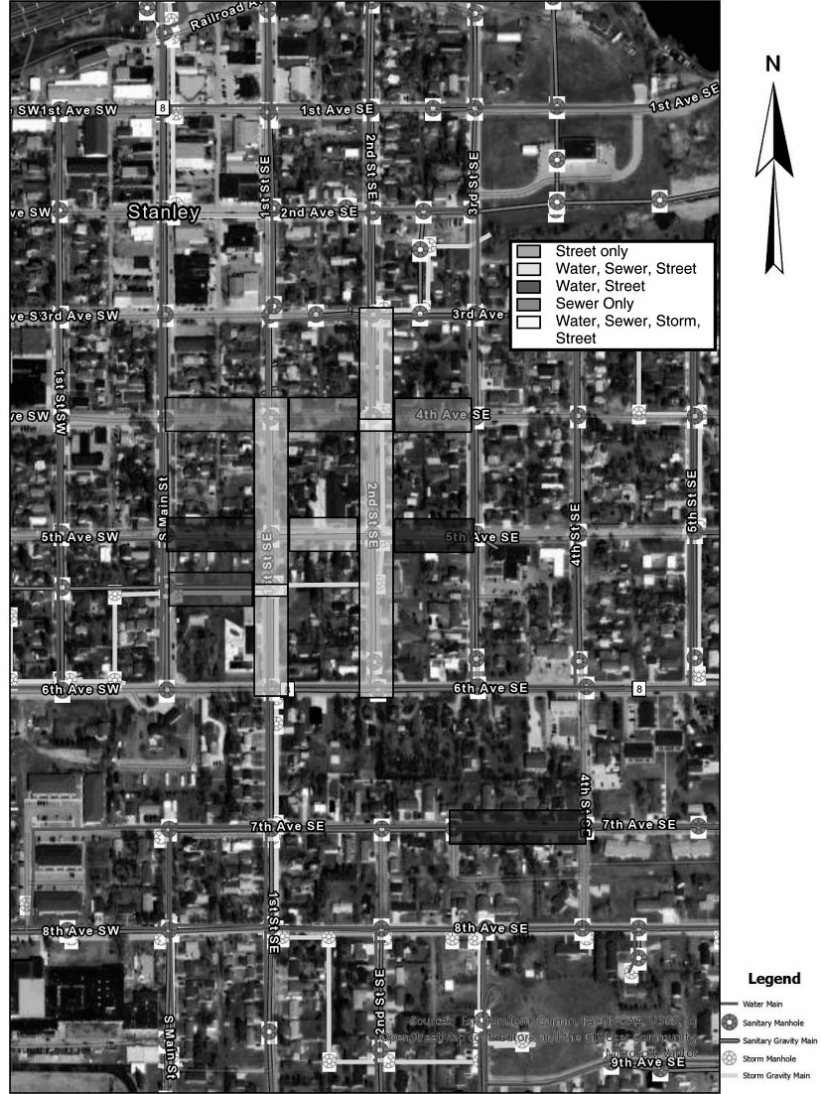

Code 67-15, Modified Public School Calendar; at 9:30 AM on Thursday, June 4, 2026, in the Peace Garden Room at the State Capitol, 600 E. Boulevard Ave., Bismarck, ND 58505.

The purpose of the proposed changes is to amend 67-15-02, Reconfiguration of Instructional Days, to rename the chapter "Four-Day School Week" and to update the criteria for which a school district can be approved the operate under a four-day school week. The proposed rules are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
