This verse is very meaningful to me today as my mother-in-law, Verlys Dille, went to be with Jesus on Wednesday, May 13. She was the best mother-in-law a guy could have!

She lived to be 96 years old. She lived with us in our home for the past 4 years. We miss her. In fact, I feel like I'm experiencing "Empty Nest Syndrome" again.

She was one of my Good News devotional "proof readers" before my articles went to the newspaper.

She was a good example to me in several ways.

She would work on various types of puzzles to keep her mind sharp. She loved to watch "Wheel of Fortune" and try to figure out what the words were, puzzle by puzzle.

She was careful about her diet. She read Prevention magazine to find out how to maintain her health.

She was careful with her finances. And, she continued to support her home church.

She would keep up with current events by watching the news. And would discuss her views on how things should be.

I would regularly see her reading her Bible and praying. Knowing and serving God was very important to her.

My daughter, Joy, wrote Verlys's obituary. Here's some excerpts:

"She possessed a gentle spirit, a strong work ethic, and a caring heart.

She discovered, early on, her love for children and learning, which made teaching a natural calling. She earned a Master's Degree from Bemidji State University in 1975. Teaching was more than a profession to Verlys—it was a gift she shared generously.

She also faithfully served through Sunday School, Bible School, and church choir. (She was a good singer.)

Verlys had a special way of making people feel welcome and cared for. She treasured friendships, stayed active in her community, and found joy in simple things.

Through every season of life, Verlys carried herself with grace, resilience, and quiet faith. She adapted to life's

changes with strength and gentleness, offering a calm and steady presence to those around her. Her faith in God was the foundation of her life and a source of comfort through both joys and hardships."

As I close, I think of how important it is to have positive Christian role models in our lives. Verlys was a good example to me.
