Staigle sees the simulator as a space for everyone: families, beginners, seasoned golfers and kids' birthday groups. The precision-oriented setup helps players focus on improving their swing. Kid-themed courses make the system accessible for the youngest players.

He is intentional about keeping Blue Cat a complement, not a competitor, to area golf courses. The simula-

tor costs \$35 per hour, whether one person or four are playing. Memberships run only from October through May.
