Becher, Brady Vollmuth, and Logan Hansen all grinding through tough at-bats.

On the mound, Thompson gave Washburn/Wilton/Center-Stanton another solid start.

Working all six innings, Thompson allowed nine hits and five runs, but only three were earned.

He issued just one walk while striking out five, keeping the Cardinals within striking distance throughout much of the contest.

Despite the pair of losses, there were several positives for Washburn/Wilton/Center-Stanton to build on.

Kjelstrup was a consistent spark offensively, collecting four hits across the two games. Wolff added three hits during the stretch, while Retterath contributed both at the plate and on the mound, combining for two hits, one RBI, and a dominant 12-strikeout pitching performance.

Perhaps most encouraging was the work of the Cardinals' pitching staff as a whole.

Retterath and Thompson combined to throw 12 innings, allowing just six earned runs while striking out 17 batters and issuing only two walks.

That kind of production on the mound gives Washburn/Wilton/Center-Stanton a chance to compete every time out.

Now, the focus turns toward finding more offensive rhythm and tightening up defensively behind strong pitching performances.

If the Cardinals can begin turning quality at-bats into bigger innings while cleaning up mistakes in the field, they have the pieces in place to start turning competitive efforts into wins as the season moves deeper into May.
