70 Democratic write-in candidates

### Nonpartisan races

For the position of Superintendent of Public Instruction, Levi Bachmeier and Tracy Layne Foss led the primary election votes over candidate Charles Tuttle, and will advance to the general election.

Bachmeier, 55.51% at 59,268 votes  
Foss, 29.85% at 31,875 votes  
Tuttle, 14.37% at 293 votes  
293 write-in candidates

In the justice for supreme court race, Jerod Tufte led over Ariston E. Johnson. Both will advance to the November election.

Tufte, 63.44% at 63,253 votes  
Johnson, 36.15% at 36,045  
402 write-in candidates

Douglas A Bahr, who is running uncontested for the unexpired justice for supreme court seat, will go on to the next stage.

Bahr, 99.48% at 97,321 votes  
508 write-in candidates

### Measure

North Dakota voters had one statewide measure to consider, Constitutional Measure No. 1 relating to the single subject requirements for constitutional amendments.

The measure proposed amending the ND Constitution to require that any future constitutional amendments contain only one subject.

This measure passed during the primary election.

of something going wrong at home," she said.

But beneath the fun, Eslinger sees something deeper. Ranch rodeos, she said, are more than entertainment. They're a nod to the working cowboy — the problemsolvers, the horsemen, the people who have to think fast and trust their mounts even faster.

"Even in the events that are purely entertainment based," she said, riders and horses are being put into unexpected situations. "That in itself is the definition of cowboy work."

She hopes the next generation sees that — and carries it forward.

"I hope they're able to keep up the wholehearted sportsmanship that has been such a part of these rodeos," she

said. And she hopes they build the same lasting friendships she's found along the way.

Eslinger doesn't pick favorites when it comes to events. She loves that every ranch rodeo is different — new stock, new challenges, new stories unfolding in the dust. That variety, paired with the deep roots of ranch work, is what keeps the sport alive. It's also what keeps people like Eslinger coming back, year after year, even when life pulls them in other directions.

For Eslinger ranch rodeo isn't just a weekend event. It reflects the kind of cowboy work she grew up with: relying on a good horse, solving problems in real time and working alongside people who understand the demands of the job.
