May 21

McLean County planners to review propane facility, gravel pit proposals

July 20 agenda also includes zoning change, conditional use and setback variance requests

The McLean County Planning and Zoning Commission is scheduled to review several land-use requests later this month, including proposals for a propane storage facility, a sand and gravel pit and multiple non-farm structures on agricultural land.

The commission is set to meet at 1:30 p.m. July 20 in the commission room on the ground floor of the McLean County Courthouse. Times listed on the agenda are tentative unless tied to a scheduled hearing or published notice.

Among the requests is an application from Rud

Propane, LLP, doing business as Rud Oil and Gas of Center, seeking a zoning change from agricultural to commercial for land described as Outlot B in the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 8, Township 146 North, Range 82 West.

The company is requesting the change to allow installation of a 30,000-gallon propane storage facility.

Commissioners are also scheduled to consider a conditional use permit request from Gravel Products, Inc., of Minot. The application involves 15 acres in the west 65 rods of the south half of the south-

west quarter of Section 15 in Horseshoe Valley Township. Jon Paul and Rachel Ravnaas are listed as landowners.

Gravel Products is seeking approval to operate a sand and gravel pit for mining, processing and selling sand and gravel products. The proposed operation would include crushing, screening, stockpiling, reclamation and hauling of processed materials.

Leon and Darlene Philbrick of Garrison have submitted a zoning change request involving Outlot B, a road easement and Outlot C in the northeast quarter of Section 19, Town-
