

## Korean POW for More Than Three Years

Andrew grew up in Fort Totten. He enlisted in the Army on September 21, 1948. His unit was 3rd Battalion, 21st Infantry, 24th Infantry Division, the first division to arrive in Korea. For the first 18 months of the war, the division was heavily engaged on the front lines with the North Korean and Chinese forces. Andrew was captured by the enemy July 12, 1950, and was a Korean prisoner of war until August 24, 1953, a period of more than three years. The National Archives show he was released through negotiations with North Korea under Operation Big Switch. He was separated from active duty on October 16, 1953.

Andrew's son, Whalen, in an interview during May 2018, describes what his dad related to him. His dad's division "ran out of ammunition, and [the enemy] shot and shot and shot, and they just kept coming. They bombed them and he was wounded twice. He had shrapnel in his shoulder and in his leg. [The enemy] took them on a death march up to a prison camp. When they got to the prison camp, my dad said they were fed kind of like seaweed, onions, and water, and that was their food for three years. They were always dreaming about what they were gonna eat when they got home. My dad said blueberry pie and fry bread, which is a local Indian kind o' bread."

Whalen says, "[My dad] is one of the most respected persons on the reservation. He still manages all his own affairs, and everybody knows who he is. There's about four or five local pow-wows in North Dakota that he used to go to, and every one of them had a spot for him to park. He'd take his RV over there, and during the pow-wow they'd honor him and stuff. Well-respected.

"He still loves America. He sticks to his traditions, and he's got his POW flag and his American flag he flies proudly." Whalen says his dad needs help now to raise the flags. "He's a little wobbly and stuff, but he does have his flags up."

Hello Readers,



## A THIRSTY WORLD NEEDS A REFRESHED CHURCH

Friends, every generation tries to satisfy their thirst. Some chase success, comfort, entertainment, money, or relationships. But the world is spiritually dehydrated because it has cut itself off from the Fountain—the Lord Himself.

In a thirsty world, God calls His people to be a refreshing presence.

This is more than a command—it's a calling, a blessing to others and to the one who obeys.

Proverbs 11:25-A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed.

Prayer Heavenly Father, open our hearts to hear Your Word so we may be filled up to be a refreshing presence in this thirsty world.

Proverbs 11:25 gives a simple promise: refresh others, and God will refresh you.

The truth of Proverbs 11:25 is this: a giving life is a flourishing life.

This isn't motivational sentiment; it's God's wisdom and character revealed—and it points us to Jesus.

The world says hold tight, but God blesses those who give—possessions, time, and energy.

Giving resets our perspective: what we have is entrusted by God to bless others. We gain freedom from being owned by our stuff, the joy of helping, and deeper dependence on God.

## 1. CONTEXT: GENEROSITY AS GOD'S WISDOM IN ACTION

Proverbs contrasts two paths: the righteous and the wicked.

In Proverbs 11, God-fearing people speak truth, walk humbly, deal honestly, trust the Lord—and live generously.

Generosity isn't a side issue; it reveals our trust, faith, and spiritual maturity.

The early church expressed this so beautifully that Acts 2:44 NLT says: "They shared everything they had" (Acts 2:44)—because when you know God's generosity, you can't be tight-fisted with His blessings.

## 2. WHAT DOES PROVERBS 11:25 REALLY MEAN?

"The generous will prosper..."

The Hebrew for generous points to one who carries blessing—someone whose life becomes a conduit of grace. The Hebrew for prosper carries the idea of being enriched—flourishing and overflowing.

This is not a prosperity gospel—it is a generosity gospel.

God is saying: a stingy soul shrivels, but a generous, Christ-centered life overflows. Those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed." The Hebrew for refresh (ravah) means to water thoroughly—to satisfy and restore.

God's principle is clear: when you pour into others, He pours into you—not karma, but covenant.

Count your blessings—and ask: where is God calling you to pour out this week? (pause)

## 3. THE GOSPEL CALL: YOU CANNOT REFRESH OTHERS UNTIL YOU ARE REFRESHED BY CHRIST

Before you can pour out, you must drink from the Living Water and receive His grace.

Jesus said: "Anyone who believes in me may come and drink!" — John 7:38 (NLT)

If you've never repented, surrendered to Jesus, and received His saving grace, your soul is dry and your spirit cannot overflow. But Christ offers forgiveness and refreshment. I can't pour from an empty cup—so I come to Jesus and be filled. Christ offers eternal life. You cannot refresh others until Jesus refreshes you.

Today, if you are thirsty, weary, sinful, or broken—come to Him. He will refresh your soul. The more we give; the more God supplies so we can give again—even comfort (see 2 Corinthians 1:4). "If we pray, we will believe; if we believe, we will love; if we love, we will serve." — Unknown author

## 4. PRACTICAL APPLICATION: HOW TO REFRESH OTHERS DAILY

Illustration: A woman at a meat distribution factory stepped into a cold room after her shift. The door

shut, locking her inside. No one heard her cries. After hours, a security guard found her and opened the door—saving her life.

He said, "Most people treat me like I'm invisible. But you greeted me every morning and said goodbye every night. Today I never heard your 'See you tomorrow,' so I knew something was wrong—and I searched until I found you."

Small kindness matters. Respect the people you pass every day, your words may refresh them more than you know.

Let's bring this home. God calls us to be fountains of refreshment in a dry world. How?

1. Refresh with your words. Proverbs 18:21 says life and death are in the tongue. Speak life—hope, Scripture, and kindness.

2. Refresh with your compassion; Listen well; a present ear can be a drink of cold water to a hurting soul.

3. Refresh with your resources. What resources can you offer to God? Give generously, meet needs, and support Gospel work—you cannot outgive God.

4. Refresh with your time. People are thirsty for presence; time may be the most generous gift you can give.

5. Refresh with the Gospel; There is nothing more refreshing than telling someone that Jesus saves. Billy Graham: "The greatest form of giving is sharing the Gospel of Christ."

6. Refresh with encouragement Assume everyone you meet is carrying a burden—be God's messenger of strength.

7. Refresh with forgiveness A forgiven person refreshes others by becoming a forgiving person.

God Himself is a cheerful giver. Consider all He has done for us. *THE DEAD SEA VS. THE SEA OF GALILEE*

Two seas in Israel are fed by the same Jordan River: The Sea of Galilee receives and gives, so it's full of life; the Dead Sea receives and never gives, so it's dead.

Don't be a Dead Sea believer. Be a Galilee believer—alive, generous, flowing, refreshing.

## 5. JESUS: THE ULTIMATE FULFILMENT OF PROVERBS 11:25

Every Proverb finds its deepest meaning in Christ. Jesus was the most generous person who ever lived. He gave His time, compassion, strength, teaching, mercy—and His life for the world. His life for the world. Paul says: "Though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that by his poverty he could make you rich." 2 Corinthians 8:9 (NLT)

Jesus refreshed the world by His cross—pouring Himself out fully. The Father raised Him in resurrection life.

This is Proverbs 11:25 in action: He refreshed others—and was refreshed. He is pleased when we who are created in his image go and refresh others.

6. PROMISE AND CHALLENGE Proverbs 11:25 is both a promise and a challenge: Promise: God will refresh you. Challenge: But you must refresh others.

As you pour out, God pours in; as you bless, God fills you; and you become more like Christ. Go! And... Refresh Others.

7. GOSPEL INVITATION Friend, you can't refresh others until you first drink deeply of the grace of Christ.

You cannot refresh others until you first drink deeply of the grace of Christ. If you have not repented, surrendered to Jesus as Lord and Savior, and trusted Him with your life, you are spiritually dry.

And The Living Water is calling your name. Come to Jesus today.

Confess your sin, lay down your pride, and receive His forgiveness and refreshment. Receive His forgiveness. Receive His refreshment. He died for you. He rose for you. Turn to Him today and be refreshed.

Friends, God is calling us to be a refreshing people—in our words, love, service, giving, and witness. The world is thirsty; the church is the well; Jesus is the Living Water.

Go! And... Refresh Others.

Heavenly Father, thank you for Your Word. Refresh us daily in Your presence so we can refresh others with love, words, service, generosity, and witness.

In Jesus' name—our Living Water. Amen.
