Grindy, both now on the retired list; Martin Sellie, A.H. Lundquist and ye editor.”

Gee was working in his print shop as usual when on his 90th birthday in February 1944, he became aware of a crowd gathering in front of his shop. He went on with his work of preparing the week's issue for publication – pretending it was just another day – although he knew it wasn't. Suddenly, the band began to play, and Powers Lake businessmen came in and congratulated him. They asked him to come outside and join in the celebration which the community had arranged for his birthday.

The fire sirens sounded and there were “three cheers” because everyone knew it didn't mean there was a fire. The band continued to play as the Stars and Stripes were raised on the community pole nearby. The Rev. L.D. Peck, pastor of Bethel Baptist Church made a speech, paying tribute to Editor Gee. Climaxing the brief ceremony in his honor, the businessmen of Powers Lake presented to Gee a birthday gift of \$106. There wasn't much the white-bearded editor could say at the moment. He was moved deeply by this expres-

sion of goodwill by his fellow townsmen. He went back to his print shop and his work. It was easier for him to express his thanks in type.

Gee retired at the age of 92 as editor of the Powers Lake Herald. The Herald was then operated by his granddaughter, Betty and Arnold Brudvik, who ran it until 1955. It ceased to be a handset publication.

Mrs. Allene Vanden Burg took over and the last issue was printed on February 1, 1957. In 1956 the Mountrail County Promoter purchased the paper and published it as a separate paper until it was incorporated with the Promoter. For a brief period, there were two newspapers in Powers Lake. In September of 1912, Vol. 1, No. 1, of the Burke County Review was issued by Roy D. Rogers.

Gee passed away at the age of 96 on November 1, 1950. He was born in New York State in 1854. Surviving him were two daughters, Blanche and Mrs. T.A. Anderson, both of Powers Lake and son Rodney of Knoxville, TN. His wife, Louise passed away in 1942. They are both buried in the Bethel Baptist Cemetery, Powers Lake.

Relatives of the Gee family still living in Powers Lake are great-grandchildren: Bonita Ledene; Larry Ledene and his wife, Betty; and great-great-granddaughter, Mindy Ledene lives in Minot.
