

Notice to Burke County Landowners to Cut Weeds Along Roads

Notice to Landowners Weed and Grass Cutting

Notice is hereby given to landowners and renters to cut all weeds and grasses along regularly traveled roads adjoining their lands, including weeds and grasses

growing within the public right-of-way bordering such highway and their lands by October 1, 2026, as provided for in Section 63-05-01 of the North Dakota Century Code. The height of the stubble to be left shall not exceed 3" and the minimum width of the cut shall be 7', with 2 cuts to be made where possible.

If weeds and grasses are not cut by this time, the township board may cause such weeds or grasses to be cut. The expense of cutting such weeds

and grasses in each township shall be certified to the County Auditor by October 31, 2026, and such charges shall become a part of the taxes to be levied against such land for 2027.
