The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on June 2, 2026, with the following present: Pine Abrahamson, Rick Braaten, Josh Buchmann, Jerid Janikowski and Nathan Miller. Chairman Braaten called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Pastor Terry Bagley shared a prayer. Guest present: Pastor Corey Jenkins.

Braaten asked for corrections or additions to the agenda. Abrahamson moved to approve the agenda. Janikowski seconded the motion, and upon a vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

The following June 2, 2026, vouchers were approved by a motion made by Abrahamson, with Buchmann seconding the motion, and upon a vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

Abrahamson moved to approve the May 19, 2026, minutes with Miller seconding the motion, and upon a vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

Miller moved to approve the May 2026 Month-End Bureau of Land Management Report, with Janikowski seconding the motion, and upon a vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

Bowman County Treasurer, Sydnee Kidd, met to present the May 2026 Treasurer's Daily Cash Settlement/Bank Reconciliation Report. Miller moved to approve the report, Abrahamson seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all members voting yes. Motion carried.

Miller moved to approve the May 2026 Recorder and Sheriff Fee Collection Reports. Buchmann seconded the motion, and upon a vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

Buchmann moved to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between Bowman County and the US Department of the Interior Bureau of Land Management North Dakota Field Office. Miller seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all members voting yes. Motion carried.

Janikowski moved to approve the Book-keeping Engagement Letter from M&L Accounting for the Jesco Apartments. Miller seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all members voting yes. Motion carried.

BCVSO Laci Coates gave an update on the Veterans Wall Dedication program.

At 10 AM Chairman Braaten called the Unorganized Township Equalization meeting to order. Tax Director Jodi Freier outlined state mandates and gave recommendations for valuation changes for Unorganized Townships. Abrahamson moved to approve the assessment rolls as presented for the Unorganized Townships, with the following changes: five percent increase for residential and commercial and eight percent decrease for agricultural. Jan-

ikowski seconded the motion. A roll call vote was requested with all members voting yes. Motion carried. Miller moved to adjourn the unorganized township equalization meeting at 10:10 AM, with Buchmann seconding the motion, and upon a vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

At 10:15 AM Chairman Braaten called the County Equalization meeting to order. Freier outlined state mandates and presented the valuation changes presented from the floor during the April Equalization meetings. Janikowski moved to approve the following changes: Commercial; seven percent increase for Bowman City, Talbot and Bowman Townships, five percent increase for Scranton, Rhame, and Gascoyne Cities, and all other townships, Residential; Seven percent increase for Bowman and Scranton Cities and Bowman and Talbot Townships, five percent increase for Rhame and Gascoyne Cities and all other townships, Agricultural; eight percent decrease. Abrahamson seconded the motion. A roll call vote was requested with all members voting yes. Motion carried. Janikowski moved to adjourn the county equalization meeting at 10:35 AM, with Buchmann seconding the motion, and upon a vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

City of Rhame Mayor Rocky Wallman met to discuss repairs to Main Street. They received a quote from Northern Improvement for \$385,220 and are asking for assistance from the County to pay for the repairs. The commissioners offered loan options. Wallman will review with his City Council for approval and report back at next county commission meeting.

Sam Fisher and Lori Eagon, Sunny Slope Township met to discuss a Township Request for County Materials for 1000 cy of gravel and four culverts. Abrahamson moved to approve the request with the county paying one hundred percent of the cost. Buchmann seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all members voting yes. Motion carried.

Bowman County Highway Superintendent, Shane Biggs, and Billy Doerr, Brosz Engineering, met to discuss road projects. Doerr presented pay application #3 from Wilson Construction of \$102,304.93 for the Old Hwy 12 Phase 2 Roadway Reconstruction Project. Doerr presented the bid opening results

for the Paulson Seed Road Reconstruction Project. The commission will not decide on the bid until the June 16, 2026 meeting.

At 11:45 AM Miller moved to adjourn the meeting, with Janikowski seconding the motion, and upon a vote, the motion was carried unanimously.
