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SECTION 00100 INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given, that separate sealed bids for the construction of **Water Storage Reservoir** will be received by the City of Bowman, North Dakota at the office of Bowman City Hall – Auditor, 101 1st St. NE., Bowman, North Dakota until 11:00 AM, local time on September 10th, 2026, and then publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of: demolition and removal of an existing 300,000 gal concrete water storage tank and the construction of a 600,000 gal concrete tank with associated piping and incidentals, along with construction of an access road and parking pad.

cations, is on file with the Owner at the Office of Auditor and the office of Brosz Engineering, Inc. 109 S. Main, Bowman, ND.
