Misialek said she wants to see the town grow and prosper. She said they have been working hard to make the town look good, as well as making sure the infrastructure is secure so it can last the next several generations.

"We are trying to set Drayton up for future generations," Misialek said. "We have to work as a team to make things happen. We all want to make the city better."

Part of Misialek's job is keeping the community informed about sewer breaks and water issues. She sends out notifications via social media to help bring essential

information to the community. "We have to work together on things," Misialek said. "Right now, we are trying to line up discounted paint to paint the community center."

She said as work continues on Drayton's infrastructure, she is involved with the engineering side and is in constant contact with the engineers working on the projects.

Although Misialek lives in Grafton, she said she spends more time in Drayton than in her own hometown. She is at the city office Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. She said she tries not

to work overtime so she doesn't have to charge the city extra. She adjusts her schedule when there are meetings she needs to attend.

She said phase one of the infrastructure projects, such as water, sewer, and street projects, hope to begin in late August. She said not every part of the city will be updated, but some sewer lines will be replaced and others will be lined. They date back to the 1940s, so it is in need of updating.

"Wherever there are issues, and they have to dig up, the streets will be redone following the updates,"

Misialek said. "We are also adding more fire hydrants than what we have now and that is a good thing." She said what she enjoys most about her job is the people she gets to work with daily as well as the community members she comes into contact with.

"It has been great getting to know the people in this town and trying to make the town better," Misialek said. "Even if I am not from here, I am here to try [to] make things better."
