Moved by Meyer and seconded by Hochhalter to approve January 21, 2026 (rescheduled to January 26th, 2026) Board of Commissioner meeting minutes as amended. All present voting aye. Minutes approved.

The Court Facilities Improvement Grant Award was approved by the Court Facilities Improvement Advisory Committee for the replacement of carpet in the Grant County courtroom, hallway, and judge's chambers, and new blinds for windows in judge's chambers. Motion made by Meyer to proceed with project, seconded by Hochhalter. Roll call vote - Meyer - aye, Hochhalter - aye, Zenker - aye. Motion carried.

Tessa Osterbauer and Amanda Dahners presented the NDSU Extension Grant County Quarterly Narrative.

Brad Darr and Craig Saul, Maintenance Division of the North Dakota Department of Transportation submitted application information on permits to add segments to the 129,000 pound truck to the roadway system. Segments included in the applications include ND Hwy 21, ND Hwy 49, and ND Hwy 31. Concerns were raised by the Board for the contributing roadways (gravel roads) and the added weight. Decision will be forwarded to NDDOT after the February 18th meeting.

Sheriff Terry Dillon presented monthly calls to service and statistics.

Dillon and Jared Fischer gave an update on the SIRN radio system implementation. Hochhalter moved to approve the initial cost of \$2,075.00 for activation fees, WIFI and group services. Seconded by Meyer. Roll call vote - Meyer - aye, Hochhalter - aye, Zenker - aye. Motion carried.

Jon Alt, Road Superintendent met with the Board to discuss truck and equipment repairs.

Being no further business, Zenker adjourned meeting at 1:07 pm. FYI: next scheduled meetings will be February 18th and March 4th, 2026.
