

City council discusses several projects

The Sentinel Butte City Council met March 16 at Sentinel Butte City Hall. Mayor Jason Lee was absent, so Council President Denise Dietz chaired the meeting.

The meeting was called to order and the council approved the agenda, as well as the minutes from last month's meeting.

Cheryl Planert came before the council and provided information about the proposed Village plan for area senior citizens. The proposed non-profit organization would encompass residents in Beach, Golva, Sentinel Butte and possibly Medora and Wibaux, MT. The overall goal of the Village is to enhance the lives of the elderly in these communities by providing them with help for things like home maintenance, housekeeping and other daily tasks, as well as providing activities and programs to keep them connected with other community members. There would be a small monthly fee for the

services that would be done by volunteers from each community.

The next agenda item was a discussion on the purchase of replacement street signs for the city. After discussing the preliminary cost estimates, that were over budget, the matter was tabled until the next meeting.

There are light bulbs on the inside and outside of City Hall that need to be replaced, and the new City Hall sign will be installed by council member Roger Clemens.

Another issue discussed are the potholes near the railroad tracks that need to be fixed. Someone will get in touch with Golden Valley County Road Foreman Pete Wirtzfeld to see if the county has any asphalt patching material for the repairs.

Next the council talked about how many fire extinguishers are needed in City Hall. Currently, there are two and a motion was made to buy one more extinguisher.

Council member

Clemens put forth the idea of putting the shop building, that can be rented out, up on bids for the space. It has been rented out for \$50 a month in the past. After a discussion, the matter was tabled until the next meeting.

A discussion then followed on advertising the office spaces in City Hall on a wider scope. With all of the new activity in Medora, there may be interest in office spaces.

City Auditor Jody Ridenhower stated that the Office-365 program needed to be updated and that a new hard drive was installed on her office computer.

The city has received a letter asking that a floodplain administrator be appointed for the City of Sentinel Butte. The council will reach out to Rick Olson to see if he would accept the position.

The last order of business for the meeting was to review the bills. A motion was made to approve payment, followed by a motion to adjourn.
