

**ABBREVIATED NOTICE OF INTENT
TO REVISE ADMINISTRATIVE
RULES RELATING TO
VIRTUAL LEARNING**

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction (NDDPI) will hold a public hearing to address proposed changes of N.D. Admin. Code 67-30, Virtual Learning; at 9:30 AM on Wednesday, September 9, 2026, in the Peace Garden Room at the State Capitol, 600 E. Boulevard Ave., Bismarck, ND 58505.

The purpose of the proposed changes is to amend 67-30-02, Virtual Schools, to update the deadline for which a school district may apply to open a new virtual school, in order to align with federal reporting timelines. The proposed rules are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the NDDPI Office of School Approval and Opportunity, ND State Capitol, 600 E. Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND 58505-0440.
