The fire hydrants will need to be flushed and a pressure check done on them. This will help with insurance rates.

The city building cement on the south side of the building needs repairs. A 20x20 slab was discussed. Keith will discuss with people who might be interested in a smaller project and get cost estimate.

Keith will work with Brian and Derek and Jesse to figure out curb stop and sidewalk problems at Walleye's Bar.

The budget was reviewed. Brian made the motion to accept the budget. Ron seconded said motion. Motion carried by a unanimous vote.

The next city council meeting will be September 14 along with the budget hearing for residents. Meeting adjourned.
