The opening day of Region 1B girls' basketball was held in Jamestown on Mon., Feb. 23.

In quarterfinal action the winners move on while losers are out. Edgeley-Kulm-Montpelier topped Maple River 49-35, Linton-HMB beat Wyndmere-Lidgerwood 43-31, LaMoire-Litchville-Marion topped Hankinson 53-20 and Sargent County beat Kidder County 53-41.

Day two winners were: EKM 43, Linton-HMB 28 and LaMoire-LM beat Sargent County 46-15.

Thurs., Feb. 26, championship night, the third and fourth place game had Linton-HMB beat Sarent County 46-31 and it took overtime to decide a Region I champion as LaMoire-LM beat Edgeley-KM 46-42.
