## Imperials Place 4<sup>th</sup> In Oakes

### *Grunefelder Ties for 6<sup>th</sup>*

The Napoleon/Gackle-Street-Imperial boys' golf team opened their season, last Mon., April 20 in Oakes. There were 76 individuals and 10 teams competing.

NGS first year head coach Jamison Fettig and his squad of 6-players carded a team score of 372 tying for fourth place with Oakes. The top three teams finishing on the day were; Linton-HMB 353, 2. New Rockford-Sheyenne 357 and Valley City 365. Others teams placing on the day were: 6. Edgeley-Kulm 373, 7. Griggs-Midkota 414, 8. Car-

ington 430, 9. LaMoure-L-M 437 and 10. Strasburg/Zeeland 530.

Freshman Brooks Grunefelder tied for 6<sup>th</sup> place after carding an 89 (42-47) for the lone Imperial to finish in the top 10. After tiebreaker holes Grunefelder ended up in 8<sup>th</sup> place.

The other top three golfers for NGS were freshman Bradley Hottman who had a 91 (48-43) to tie for 14<sup>th</sup> place. Junior Jackson Piatz finished in 23<sup>rd</sup> place with a 95 (47-48) and eighth grader Greydyn Ryum finished in 31<sup>st</sup> place to round out the NGS

team score with a 97 (53-44).

The other two Imperials scoring on the day were junior Brenden Zenker tied for 35<sup>th</sup> with a 99 (54-45) and freshman Carson Piatz tied for 35<sup>th</sup> with a 99 (54-45).
