# Imperials Come Up Short In Super Region Golf

## Hottman State Qualifies

A super region golf tournament was held last Tues., May 26 at the Jamestown Country Club for the Class B Region 3 and Region 4 boy's golfers.

The lone Imperial to state qualify for the Imperials was freshman, Bradley Hottman. Hottman carded an 85 (44-41) and finished in 23<sup>rd</sup> place.

The top 4 teams earned the right to advance to the State Class B Golf Tournament which was held at Carrington on Tuesday and Wednesday, June 2 and 3. In addition to the four teams, the top 20 individuals who were not on a qualifying team also advance.

In action at Jamestown there were 142 individual golfers and 25 teams, all hoping to extend their seasons.

First year Napoleon/Gackle-Streeter head golf coach Jamison Fettig and his six golfers finished in 10<sup>th</sup> place as a team, with a 353-team score. Other Imperials placing and scores on the day were: freshman Brooks Grunefelder 88 (44-44) 35<sup>th</sup>; junior Jackson Piatz 89 (45-44) 40<sup>th</sup>; freshman Carson Piatz 91 (45-46) 50<sup>th</sup>; freshman Greydyn Ryum 92 (46-46) 53<sup>rd</sup>; and junior Brenden Zenker 107 (58-49) 113<sup>th</sup>.

Teams advancing to state and representing Regions 3 and 4 are: 1) Rugby 319, 2) Harvey-Wells County 321, 3) Linton/HMB 338, 4) Bishop Ryan 339. The other top 10 teams placing were: 5) Valley City 340, 6) Bot-

tineau 341, 7) Northern Lights 349, 8) Our Redeemer's 351, 9) Westhope Newburg 353, 9) Napoleon/G-S 353.

Due to 12 golfers in the top 20 already advancing to the state tournament, as they were part of the four teams advancing, the top 32 golfers will now advance, which brings the total to 20 individuals not on a state qualifying team from Region 3 & 4 advancing to state.

### NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that a Primary Election will be held in Logan County on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, for nominating candidates for Congressional, Statewide, Judicial, and County offices, for electing officers in the cities of Napoleon, Gackle, Lehr and Fredonia, and for voting on state and local measures.

All elections will be conducted by Mail Ballot. Applications were mailed from the office of the County Auditor on April 20, 2026. Persons not receiving an application may obtain one from the office of the County Auditor or at

the following website: [vote.nd.gov](http://vote.nd.gov).

The arrangement of candidate names appearing on ballots in your precinct may vary from the published sample ballots, depending upon the precinct and legislative district in which you reside.

One polling location will be open on Election Day, June 9, 2026, in the Commissioner's Room of the Logan County Courthouse located at 301 Broadway, Napoleon, ND. The hours will be from 9:00am to 7:00 pm Central Time on Election Day, June 9, 2026. Ballots for all precincts will be available. A voter

assistive device will be available at the polling location on Election Day. A secure drop box is located outside, at the bottom of the ramp, of the south entrance of the Logan County Courthouse located at 301 Broadway, Napoleon, ND. Mail ballots must be received by the close of polls on election day or placed in the secure drop box by 7:00pm CT on June 9, 2026.
