### Baked Swiss Cheese & Ham

- Ingredients:**  
1/2 pkg. (8 oz.) creamette large rings, uncooked  
3/4 C onion, chopped  
2 tbsp margarine or butter  
1 1/2 C cooked ham, cubed  
1 can (10 3/4 oz.) condensed cream of mushroom soup  
1 container (8 oz.) sour cream  
1 1/2 C (6 oz.) shredded Swiss cheese  
2 eggs  
1/4 C milk  
2 to 3 tsp Dijon style mustard  
1 can (2.8 oz.) French-fried onions

Cook pasta according to pkg. directions. Preheat oven to 350 degrees: in a small skillet, over med heat, cook in margarine or butter until tender. In a large bowl, combine all ingredients except French-fried onions, mix well. Spoon into greased 11x17 in baking dish. Cover, bake 35 minutes or until hot and bubbly. Uncover, top with French-fried onions Bake 5 minutes longer.
