





The 2026 Summit will feature speakers, a tradeshow, breakout sessions, and a unique, fun-filled closing session. Livestock and crop farmers that are interested in livestock development will have an opportunity to network with industry leaders. ND county and township officers can learn about livestock development opportunities for their communities. The event will be hosted by Emcee, Bridgette Readel of Lilac Lane Media and WDAY Radio.
