The season will run from Apr.11 through May 17. There are 8,490 licenses available in 21 open units. Bag limit is one bearded or male wild turkey.

Deadline to apply is Feb. 11. Only residents are eligible. Apply online at gf.nd.gov. Licenses issued by weighted lottery.

#### Barnes County Commission January 6, 2026 Valley City, ND 58072

The Barnes County Commission met in regular session on Tuesday, January 6, 2026, with Bill Carlblom, Mike Schwehr, Pete Paulson, and Shawn Olauson. Vicky Lovell was present via telephone. Chairman Bill Carlblom called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m., roll call was taken, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and the agenda was reviewed.

#### Bravera Insurance

Scott Faehnrich, Bravera Insurance agent, discussed various ways he could save the county money by insuring through Bravera with Scott as our NDIRF agent.

#### Corrections

Jeremy Wolff presented a quote of \$25,490.00 plus and annual maintenance fee of \$3,593 for an Idemia LiveScan fingerprint machine. Bill Carlblom made a motion to approve the purchase if Idemia would agree to a two-year warranty before they would start charging an annual maintenance fee; Pete Paulson seconded the motion. The motion carried upon roll call vote with all members voting yes.

#### NDDOT

Brad Darr, NDDOT Maintenance Division Director, joined the commission meeting via Teams to discuss a 129,000 lb Large Truck Network that is being proposed on a network of state highways. Bill Carlblom made a motion to follow the state proposal recommendation of allowing 129,000 lb trucks on the state highway network system. Mike Schwehr seconded the motion. The motion carried with Mike, Bill, Pete, and Shawn voting yes and Vicky voting no.

The Veteran's Office put 2,638 miles on the van with 54 rides. Shawn Olauson reminded everyone of the Pancake Feed coming up for the Historical Society. Mike Schwehr reported that the CCHD director is out on medical leave and Megan Velure will be the interim director. Vicky Lovell reported the Strategic Planning meeting at the library went well. The Skyline Villa is installing a new boiler. Bill Carlblom has an annual review of the Extension Office personnel coming up.
