God's Amazing Knitting

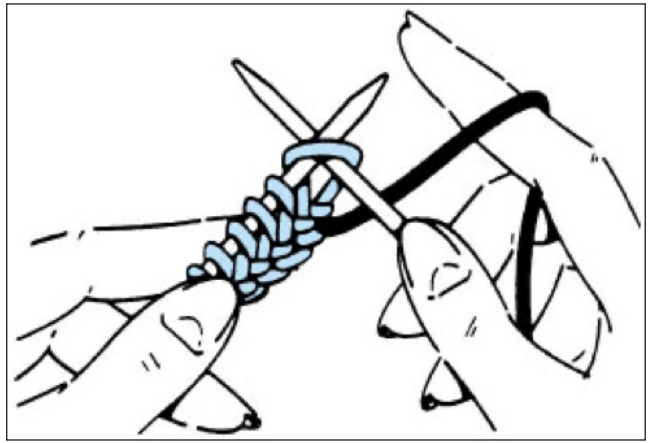
Sarah, my daughter, has a hobby that fascinates me. She can take a ball of yarn and turn it into a stocking cap. I love to see her exercise her God-given creativity. King David used the imagery of "knitting" when he described how our lives came into being. "You made all the delicate, inner parts of my body and knit me together in my mother's womb. Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous—how well I know it. You watched me as I was being formed in utter seclusion, as I was woven together in the dark of the womb. You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed." (Psalm 139:13-16, NLT)

Those verses answer one of the most basic questions of life: "Where did I come from?"

When a young person gets old enough to start asking that fundamental question, they may also begin to wonder ... "Why am I here?"

Are there more answers in the Bible to big questions like those? I read a verse of Scripture in which God answered both of those questions through a prophet named Jeremiah: "The word of the Lord came to me, saying, 'Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.'" (Jeremiah 1:5 NIV)

The prophet Isaiah made a similar discovery when God spoke to him: "Now the Lord says — He who formed me

in the womb to be His servant to bring Jacob back to Him and gather Israel to Himself" (Isaiah 49:5 NIV)

Both of these men discovered that they had come into existence because of God's power and ability to initiate life in the womb. They were also told why they were given the opportunity to live. They discovered their purpose.

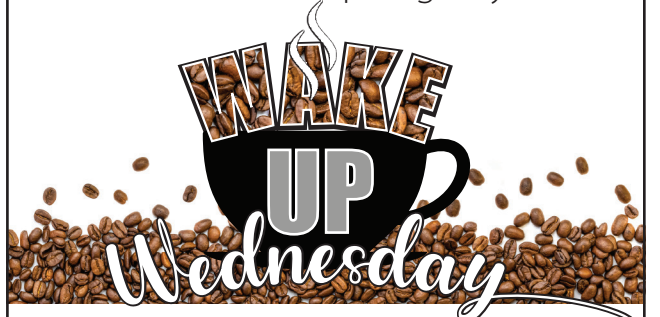
Every life is precious, because we receive life as a gift from God. And every life has a purpose. Do you know what your purpose is? If you don't, ask God to show you.

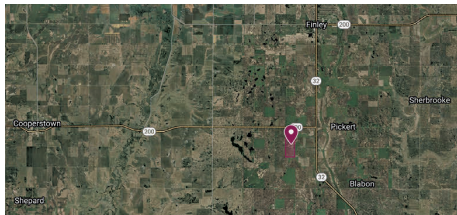
